FAQ

Why can't I clean it up myself?

Proper cleanup of toxins requires identification of the toxin, the recommended clean-up process for the toxin kind, and the proper protocol depending on the type of item being restored; such as electronics, clothing, and different surface materials. Invisible particles can travel through your ductwork, windows, HVAC, and air vents getting deep in to any surface. Safely cleaning these particles also requires the appropriate safety measures. In short, regular cleaning services are not sufficient and could be unsafe.
